The meeting was called to order by James Holland, President of the Council. The invocation was given by Rusty Wheeles. # RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SELECTION OF A CONTRACTOR FOR CDBG PROJECT LR-ED-PF-13-008

**WHEREAS**, the City of Muscle Shoals has duly advertised and received construction bids for CDBG Project # LR-ED-PD-13-008; and

**WHEREAS**, Golden Construction Company of Muscle Shoals, Alabama has submitted the lowest bid for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, this contractor has been determined not to be on the List of Ineligible Contractors; and

WHEREAS, the complete bid tabulation is attached to this Resolution; now

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Muscle Shoals does hereby authorize its Mayor, David H. Bradford, to sign contract documents with the above mentioned contractor for the completion of CDBG project LR-ED-PF-13-008 for a contract amount of \$143,420.10.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has been informed Irby Development Company presented a petition for vacation of certain streets and alleyways within the City at the August 19, 2013 regular meeting of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, it is determined that Irby Development Company was not the owner of the property abutting said streets and alleyways at the time of the presentment of the petition; and

**WHEREAS**, the said Irby Development Company had no standing to bring the petition before the Council prior to becoming the owner of the property abutting the streets and alleyways;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama that the action taken by the Council on the petition of Irby Development Company for the vacation of certain streets and alleyways within the City, same being Resolution Number 2632-13, is hereby repealed and held for naught.

Council Member Pampinto seconded the motion and upon said motion being put to a vote, a roll call was had and the vote was recorded as follows:

President Holland announced the vote and declared that the resolution was approved.

President Holland announced that the next item of business was consideration of a resolution to authorize the sale of dirt to Irby Development.

Council Member Pampinto introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:

STATE OF ALABAMA COLBERT COUNTY

## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 2651 - 13**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has been informed that it has a surplus of dirt that is currently stockpiled on City property and that said quantity of dirt is in greater amounts than necessary to meet the needs of the City for its current or anticipated future use; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has caused the value of the dirt to be ascertained and is informed that a fair price for the surplus dirt is \$0.50 per cubic yard; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has received a proposal to purchase surplus dirt from the City and has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to dispose of the excess dirt; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is desirous of doing so and that the excess dirt shall be sold in its "as is, where is", condition and location to Irby Development Company in such quantity as may be purchased by said Irby Development Company so long as the quantities purchased does not deplete the supply of dirt owned by the City below the quantity that may be needed by the City as determined by the City's engineer for future or anticipated projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is informed that there is no current need of the surplus dirt for future or anticipated projects at this time;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the City has no current or anticipated use for said dirt and that the removal of the dirt from the current stockpile is not detrimental to the City's interests and the receipt of the funds for the purchase of the said surplus dirt is beneficial to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Muscle Shoals, Alabama that the sale of the surplus dirt up to 35,000.00 cubic yards which currently stockpiled by the City is hereby approved. The price of the surplus dirt shall be \$0.50 per cubic yard and shall be calculated per cubic yard of dirt removed from the City's stockpile. The terms of the sale shall include that the City shall not transport or deliver the dirt but shall require the purchaser to accept the direct in its "as is, where is" condition. The Purchaser shall be responsible for loading and transporting the dirt and shall maintain accurate records of the number of loads and amounts of dirt removed from the City's stockpile. Further terms shall include that the quantity of dirt obtained by the Purchaser shall be limited to the quantity as may be purchased by said Irby Development Company so long as the quantities purchased does not deplete the supply of dirt owned by the City below the quantity that may be needed by the City as determined by the City's engineer for future or anticipated projects. The City shall require payment of the surplus dirt based upon the calculation of the quantity of dirt removed from the City's stockpile and said payment shall be due upon presentment of the invoice for the surplus dirt.

Council Member Lockhart seconded the motion and upon said motion being put to a vote all voted "AYE" and "NAYS" were none.

President Holland announced that the resolution had been approved.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon the motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.
